Reading Buddies

The SCLS Reading Buddies Program was created by our teachers to provide children with the opportunity to improve their reading, comprehension, listening, and instruction skills. The program makes reading fun and interactive, and perhaps a little less like work! Each grade is paired with a partner class (K-4th, 1st-5th, 2nd-8th, 3rd-7th, PreK-6th). Twice monthly, the Integrated Language Arts teacher of the older student and their lower grade partner have their students meet to work together on this reading project. The older student chooses a book that is grade/ level appropriate for their younger partner, and prior to getting together, students will pre-read, re-read and formulate questions to ask the younger student about key events and information in the story. In the photo to the right a 4th grader reads to a Kindergartener.

The photo on the cover also displays Reading Buddies in front of the “Royal Reader”, part of the “Bookaneer” Book Fair held in September.

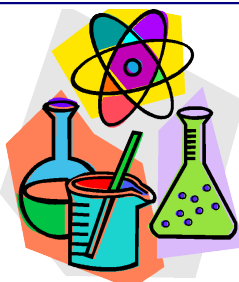


“Never Tire of Being MERCIFUL”

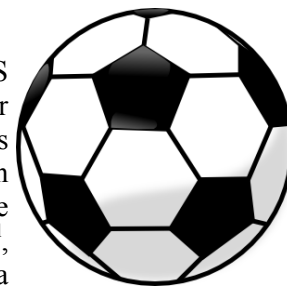
Academics: Spotlight on Science

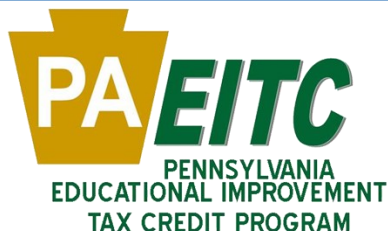

The purpose of the club was for students to choose their own topic and conduct research independently with Miss Radic to guide them. In the spring of 2016, SCLS began working with “Soccer Shots”, an engaging children’s soccer program with a focus on character development. The children met with their Soccer Shots coach once a week for 8 weeks and focused on individual skill, fitness, and sportsmanship. We plan to continue working with Soccer Shots in the spring of 2017!





Educational Improvement Tax Credit Program

The Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) Program provides a mutual benefit to businesses and students and their families. While it may seem too good to be true, the fact is: a business can receive a 75% tax credit for every dollar donated. The tax credit increases to 90% if the business commits to donating for 2 consecutive years. At the 90% rate, if a business donates \$1,000, they would receive a \$900 tax credit. The donations go to scholarship organizations and funds can be designated for Saint Catherine Labouré School students in the form of scholarships. 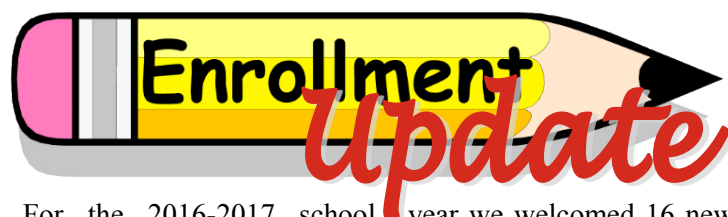

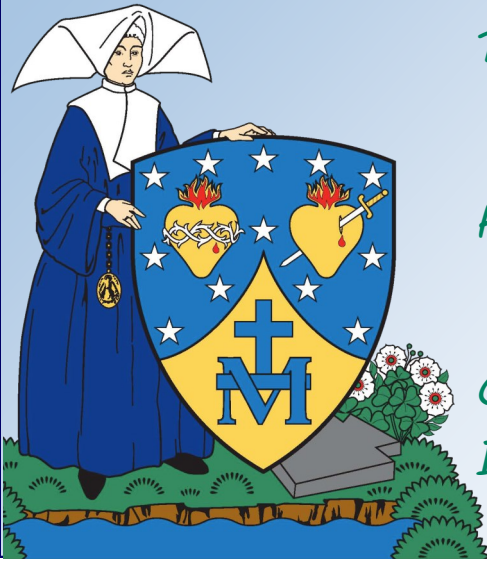
