Mandatory Fall Fundraiser

Welcome back to another school year at St. Catherine Laboure! The PTO is starting off the year with our annual mandatory Fall Fundraiser, which helps support our school throughout the year and benefits <u>all</u> of our children. Monies raised from this fundraiser pay for our school nurses, supplies for Kindergarten & 8th grade graduations, school-wide events such as Science Explorers, supplies for Halloween & Christmas parties and teacher wish list items, just to name a few. This is the <u>ONLY</u> required fundraiser, and it is <u>MANDATORY</u> that all families participate, as per the SCLS Handbook. We appreciate the understanding and participation of our entire school family!

It is very important that each family participates either by selling items or by taking the buyout option. This year we are offering two types of sale materials, as well as the buyout. Materials will be sent home on Wednesday, September 13. Money and orders are due by Wednesday, October 4. Any Kid Stuff coupon books not sold **must be returned** by this time as well.

Option #1: Sell \$125 worth of items, per family, across the two fundraiser choices.

*Joe Corbi Pizza, Mrs. Fields Cookies/ Desserts & Designer Collection Gifts catalogs (pick-up for these items is Thursday, November 9 from 3:30-6:30 in the gym)

*Kid Stuff coupon books are \$25 per book (any unsold books must be returned by the fundraiser deadline)

Option #2: Buyout of \$75 per family. Money and unpurchased Kids Stuff books are due Wednesday, October 4.

<u>Note:</u> You cannot crossover the two options, i.e. sell \$50 worth of items and give \$25 towards the buyout. **You must choose only one option**.

Any buyouts not paid by January 1, 2018, will be charged \$100. Please turn in your orders or buyout by the deadline to avoid this late fee!
