

Fisherman Crochet Prayer Shawl (Peggy Brown – 2008)

This pattern is based on the classic basket weave crochet stitch and made to the length desired.

You can modify the width simply by adding or subtracting in multiples of 6 stitches.

Materials: 3-4 skeins Fisherman (Aran) worsted weight yarn. Size L crochet hook.



Chain 84

Row 1: Double crochet in second chain from hook and continue across to form the foundation row.

Pattern:

Row 2: Working from back, (*double crochet around back post (DCBP) of each of the next 3 sc, working from front, double crochet around front post (DCFP) each of the next 3 sc - basket weave pattern); rep from * across, ending by working a half double crochet (HDC) in last stitch. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 3: Working around dc post of previous row, BPDC around each of the next 3 stitches, FPDC around each of the next 3 stitches; repeat this pattern across, ending by working a HDC in the turning chain; chain 2 and turn.

Row 4: Repeat row 3.

Row 5: FPDC around each of the next 3 stitches, BPDC around each of the next 3 stitches; repeat this pattern across by working a HDC in turning chain. Chain 2 and turn.

Rows 6 and 7: Repeat row 5 twice.

Repeat Pattern rows until desired length of shawl.
