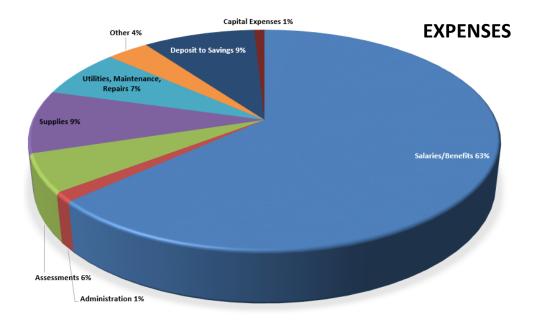
SOME HIGHLIGHTS

- Our Parish Family provided food to distribute 75 plus Thanksgiving dinner baskets to needy families, as well as donating year round to feed families in need.
- Provided 1,000 plus gifts to families less fortunate through our Christmas Giving Tree and Adopt-A-Family programs.
- Collected over 5,000 pounds of food, 40 request (total 150 bags), grocery store gift cards: \$1,200) We share our bounty of food with the Catholic Worker House in Harrisburg.
- Approximately 25 Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion made over 2,000 visits to our homebound parishioners.
- We offered weekly Communion Services in the five nursing homes under our care, in addition to monthly Mass.
- Provided love, support and nourishment to over 90 families grieving the loss of a loved one through our Arimathean and Bereavement ministries.
- Raised \$6,460 for Morning Star Pregnancy Services through their Baby Bottle program.
