What Does PTO Pay For?

Welcome back to another year at SCLS! Our newly elected PTO Board is very excited for the year ahead and spent time this summer meeting to plan many fun events for our students and families. We are looking forward to some familiar favorites like our Ice Cream Socials and Grandparents Bingo... As well as some new events like a Holiday Bazaar and Pancake Breakfast. We are thrilled to work closely with Mrs. Vail to bring some fresh breath into the PTO this year!

The PTO Board is hoping to have many families join us this year. We are always looking for both "old" and "new" families to sign up to help at our events (there is something every month of the school calendar to help with!) and attend our meetings. One of the best ways you can help the PTO, however, is by supporting our fundraisers.

The Fall Fundraiser, which is the <u>ONLY</u> mandatory fundraiser of the year, is the PTO's most important fundraiser of the year; your participation in this fundraiser is crucial to meet our fundraising goals. Attending our restaurant and retail nights, clipping and sending in Box Tops, ordering from our Sub and Easter Candy sales are also all ways that help the PTO bring in necessary funding.
