## A Message from the Principal, Mrs. Vail

Dear Parents and Families:

As each new month turns over on the calendar, I marvel at how quickly the school year is going. In the blink of an eye we will be celebrating Christmas and the new year of 2019 will be close behind!

Our parish theme this Advent season is Journey to Bethlehem. A wonderful family tradition is the making of an Advent Wreath, and the saying of the special prayers as you light each of the four candles week by week. I would also like to remind you that our re-enrollment process for the school year 2019-2020 has been moved up this year. A School Messenger Alert went out just before Thanksgiving, but I will repeat the same information here for those of you who might have missed it.

This year we are joining the majority of all Catholic schools nation-wide in having our new student registration process, during Catholic Schools Week, the last week of January. Because we always want to make sure that our current families have first choice in reserving a place for the new school year, our re-enrollment process will also move up, taking place at the beginning of the month of January. You will receive a letter of intent during the Christmas holiday that will outline the re-enrollment process. In order to save your spot, we do require that the form be returned, along with the fee. For your convenience, we will be accepting online credit card payments this year.

Re-enrollment school fees for 2019 - 2020

Students in Kindergarten – Grade 8 On or before February 1, 2018 = \$100 After February 1, 2018 - \$150 Students in Pre- K 3 or Pre- K 4 On or before May 1, 2018 = \$100 After May 1, 2018 - \$150

As we walk together on our Advent journey to Bethlehem, may the spirit of hope, faith and belief be ever in our hearts and actions!
