Mandatory Fall Fundraiser

Welcome back to another school year at Saint Catherine Labouré! The PTO is starting off the year with our annual mandatory Fall Fundraiser, which helps support our school throughout the year and benefits <u>all</u> of our children. The main goal of the Fall Fundraiser is to cover the cost of the school nurse (see last page of what the funds all cover). This is the <u>ONLY</u> required fundraiser, and it is <u>MANDATORY</u> that all families participate, as per the SCLS Handbook. We appreciate the understanding and participation of our entire school family!

It is very important that each family participates either by selling items from the catalogs (*Charleston Wrap*: The Merry Gift Wrap Guide and Kitchen and Home) or by taking the buyout option. Money and orders are due by Wednesday, October 2nd.

<u>Option #1</u>: Sell \$200 worth of items, per family. <u>Pick-up for these items is Thursday, November 14th from 3:30-7:00 in Room 103.</u>

Option #2: Buyout of \$125 per child. Families with two or more children, the cost for the buyout is \$150.

<u>Note:</u> You cannot crossover the two options, i.e. sell \$50 worth of items and give \$50 towards the buyout. **You must choose only one option**.

Any buyouts not paid by October 16th, will be charged a \$50 late fee. Fall Fundraiser obligations that continue not to be paid will result in additional consequences (please refer to the letter in the Fall Fundraiser packet for additional information).

Welcome back to another year at SCLS! Our PTO Board is very excited for the year ahead. We have many special events planned, and we are thrilled to welcome Mrs. Reagan to SCLS and are looking forward to incorporating her ideas into the year ahead.

Did you know that the PTO pays for:

- The Salary of the School Nurses This funding allows a nurse to be at our school five days a week for a full
 day. There are several diabetic students and students with allergies who rely on a nurse on a daily basis. But
 the truth is that sicknesses and accidents happen each day, and every single student at SCLS benefits from
 having a nurse in the building when students are at school.
- The School Messenger System Used every single day, this is how email communications are sent to all SCLS families to convey information, whether it be an emergency announcement or reminders.
 - MMS PTO has paid for half of the cost of the MMS system, which is utilized by both school families and staff to keep track of grades and teacher communications.
- Science Explorers Indoor Field Trip For the last two years, PTO has sponsored this activity for students in 1st through 5th grades at no cost to the parents for students to participate.
- Teacher "Wish Lists" The PTO gives ALL teachers including learning support and specials money to spend for items or projects within their classrooms that they would otherwise pay for out of pocket.
- Ice Cream Socials The Fall and Spring socials are paid for entirely by the PTO at no cost to students and their families to attend.
 - Catholic Schools Week Teacher & Student Appreciation Luncheons
 - Kindergarten & 8th Grade Graduation Receptions
- Halloween & Christmas Parties, Middle School Halloween Dance and Cookies & Cocoa While families are
 asked to help contribute snacks for these events, the PTO covers the bulk of the cost for all these special
 events.

So how do we raise the funding needed to pay for it all?

- The Fall Fundraiser This is the <u>ONLY</u> mandatory fundraiser of the year, is the PTO's most important fundraiser of the year. Your participation in this fundraiser is crucial to meet our fundraising goals!
