The Bishop McDevitt Music Department offers many exciting opportunities for young instrumentalists in 4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grades. Each child receives a weekly 20-minute lesson, which allows your child to participate in their respective school's concert bands or beginner band.

Friday, September 13<sup>th</sup> 4pm Buddy Night with the Bishop McDevitt Marching Band: Students in grades 6, 7, and 8 are <u>required</u> to participate in Buddy Night at the Bishop McDevitt High School football game on Friday,

September 13th. Students should report to the Bishop McDevitt High School band room at 4pm that day. This night will afford the students an opportunity to enjoy fellowship with current high school band members in addition to playing high school level pep band repertoire. The night's culminating activity will be a chance for the middle school students to play on the field with their high school comrades.
