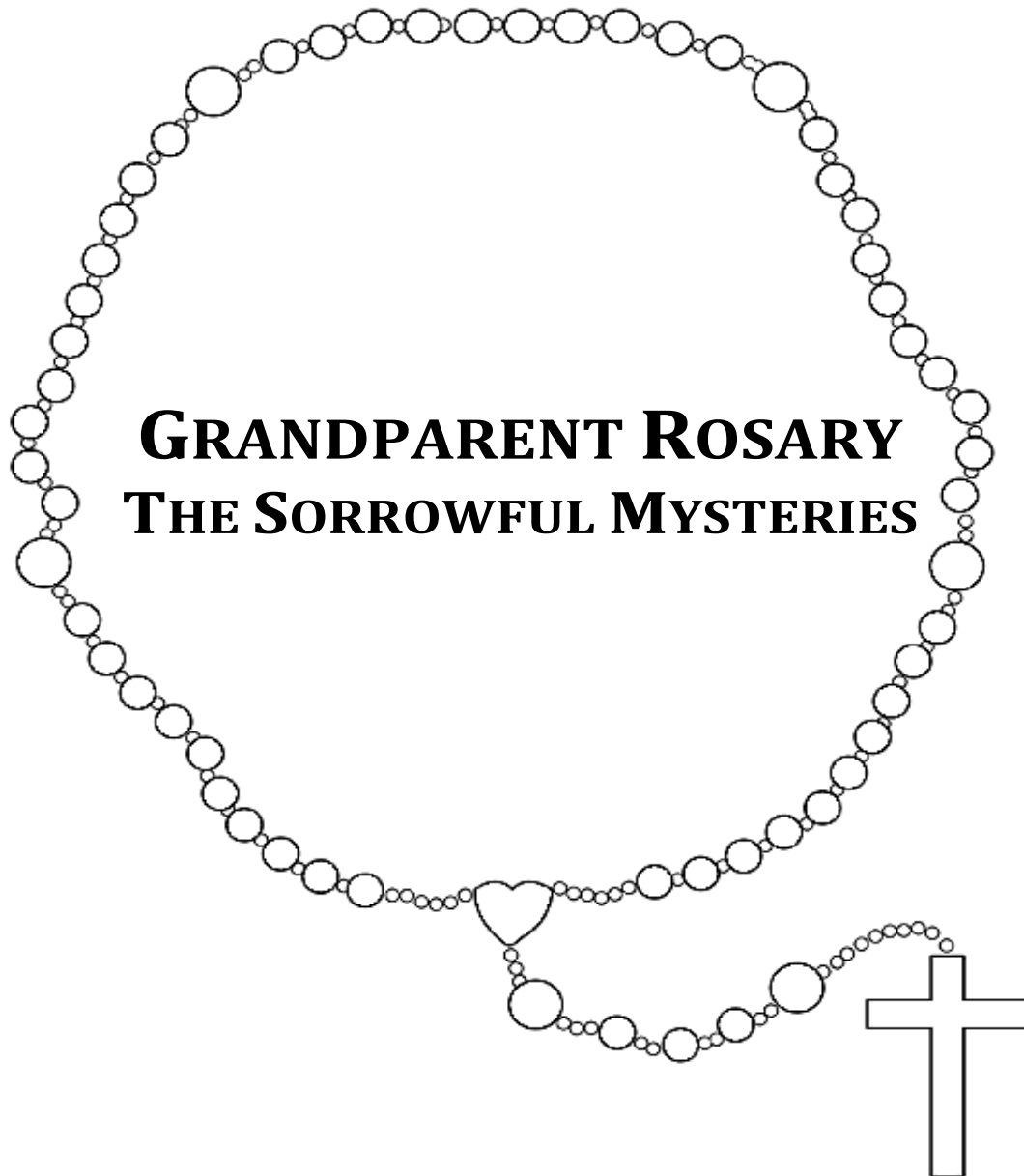

**Glory be to the Father**, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

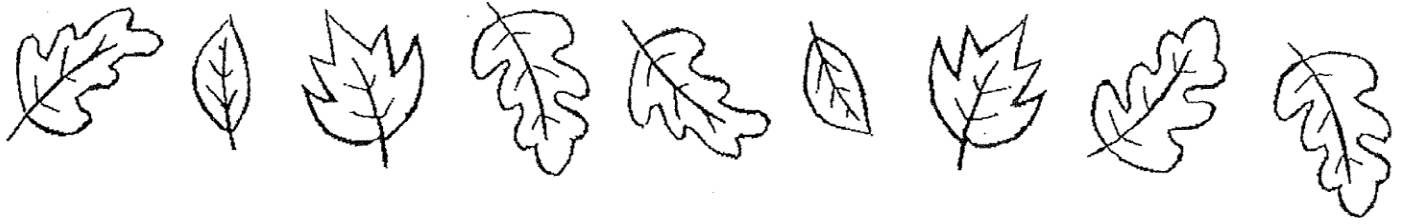

THAT WE MAY BE MADE WORTHY OF THE PROMISES OF CHRIST. AMEN.

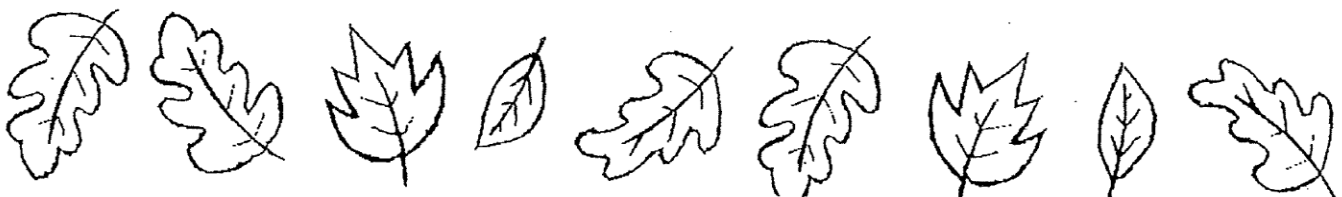


## Blessing of Grandparents
