<u>ALL</u> volunteers at St. Catherine Laboure school require clearances, *prior* to any involvement with youth. If you are hoping to volunteer in any way this year, please take the time now to complete the process to obtain a youth protection badge. The PTO will not be able to allow any volunteers (if we reach a point where volunteers are allowed into the school building this year) at school functions if they do not have up to date current clearances.

PTO Dress Down Pass Sale!

The PTO is selling a **<u>9-pack</u>** of Dress Down passes for the year ahead!

- Sale runs until **Friday**, **September 24**, **2021**. An instruction sheet to mark your passes will be sent home the week of September 27.
- The cost for 9 Dress Down Passes is \$20 per pass (this is a change from last year; while there is no longer a discount for purchasing multiple passes, the price for one pass remains the same).
 - You will receive 9 passes in total, which can be used beginning Monday, October 4. Passes cannot be used on a Mass day, on a field trip day or on any day a Dress Down Day is being offered as a school fundraiser (such as for mini-THON, dress down days for the missions, Royal Run day, etc.). Passes can be used all at once or spread out throughout the year your choice!
 - Please follow the Dress Down guidelines in the Student Handbook (page 32).
- Mrs. Reagan reserves the right to announce at the end of a school day that passes cannot be used the following day.
 - This is the <u>ONLY</u> PTO Dress Down opportunity available for the coming year.
 - Teachers will have a list of students in their homeroom who bought the passes and will mark them off until all 9 are used.
