Classroom Rules, Responsibilities, and Rewards

- 1. You are responsible for supplying the required materials: a <u>sharpened pencil</u>. A <u>choral folder with music</u> will be provided for each student. In order to be prepared for Chorus each day, you will need both of these items.
- 2. Participate 100% in all classroom activities, including singing.
- 3. If rehearsal is canceled for any reason, students will be notified and should resume their normal activity at that time.
- 4. Students must not hold private conversations during Mass.
- 5. Follow all the required postures of the Mass (kneeling, sitting, standing, bowing etc.). In these matters, the members of the choir should be an example to the worshiping community.
- 6. Show up on time! All students should be seated in their assigned section with their appropriate supplies.
- 7. Students must allow others to get their fair share by taking turns in a lead role.
- 8. Students must attend at least two of the three rehearsals per week.
- 9. There is no food, drinks, or gum allowed in the chorus room.
- 10. Refrain from putting on lotion, perfume, or makeup in the chorus room.
- 11. Be responsible for your belongings and also of those entrusted to you. Choral folders and music are loaned to students, and if lost, the student has the financial responsibility of replacing them. Choral folders and music may be taken home only after permission from the Choral Director is given and the folder is signed out in the class binder.
- 12. Refrain from touching the piano, keyboard, telephone, and classroom computer, unless you have permission from the Choral Director. Also do <u>not</u> enter the Music Office without permission.
- 13. The teacher, not the bell, dismisses the class.
- 14. Show respect for others, for your school, and for your teacher.
- 15. Remain positive and always do your best in every activity you perform.

Each student is expected to follow the above classroom rules. If consistent positive attitude and behavior is displayed, students may receive:

- 1. Verbal and Nonverbal Praise
- 2. Positive phone call or e-mail

Rules for choir are the same as in music class & have been reviewed with the students. The consequences of not following the rules will be -

- 1. First Warning
- 2. 2nd Warning, sent back to class
- 3. Third Warning, miss 1 rehearsal and liturgy or performance
- 4. Removal for the remainder of the school year

Mass Attire

Each student has the responsibility of using the proper school uniform, or they will not be able to sing at Mass. Students should take pride in their appearance as a student at St. Catherine Labouré School. They should be neat and well-groomed and in the proper school uniform worn properly at all times. Belts are to be worn, shirts and blouses tucked in, girls' skirts/dresses at a proper length, and shoes tied. Our attire demonstrates pride, caring, unity, and spirit here at SCLS.
