Candidates interested in running for the PTO Board (President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer) should be driven, motivated, well organized and willing to be a team player. **ALL CANDIDATES MUST HAVE THEIR CLEARANCES!** The PTO Board coordinates schoolwide events as well as events specific to certain grades - you must be willing to spend time planning for events in grades where you do not have a student. The PTO coordinates and helps all Homeroom parents and works hard at teacher appreciation. The other main responsibility of the PTO is fundraising and coming up with projects which will benefit the entire school. The PTO Board must be willing to be available to meet and plan as a Board. Generally, the duties of each Board position are as follows:

- **President** - Coordinates all events and fundraising and manages each committee. Must be willing to take a leading role in communicating with the Principal and Pastor and serves as a guide for Homeroom parents.
- **Vice President** - Assists the President in all event coordination and fundraising.
- **Secretary** - Puts together the monthly newsletter as well as any paperwork needed for meetings. Sends reminders to Homeroom parents before classroom events and works to ensure all volunteers have clearances.
- **Treasurer** - Manages all money that the PTO raises and writes checks for anything that needs to go out. Must be willing to make frequent trips to the bank and keep track of the PTO budget.

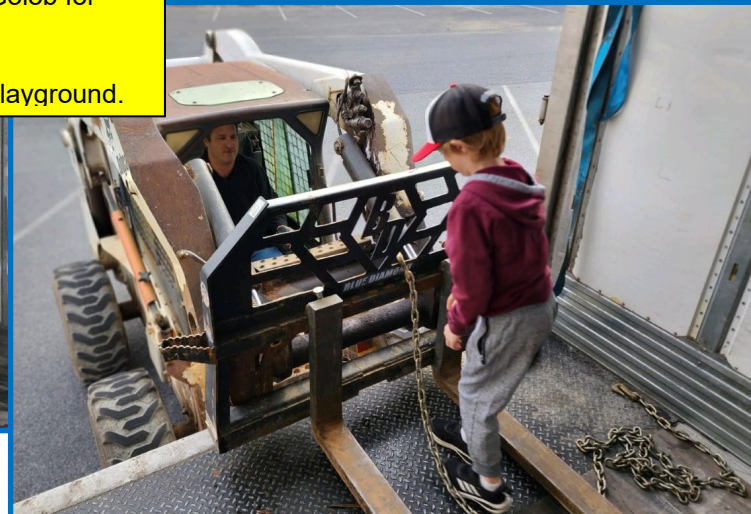

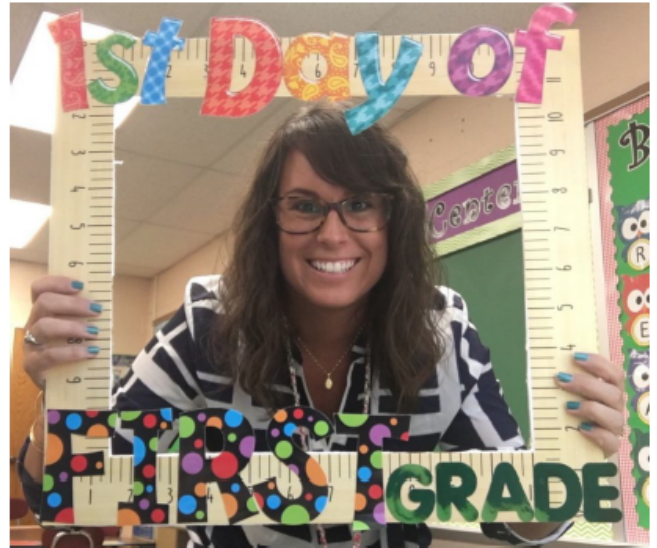

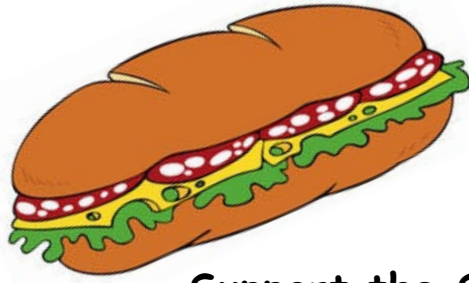
