A Message from the Principal, Mrs. Reagan

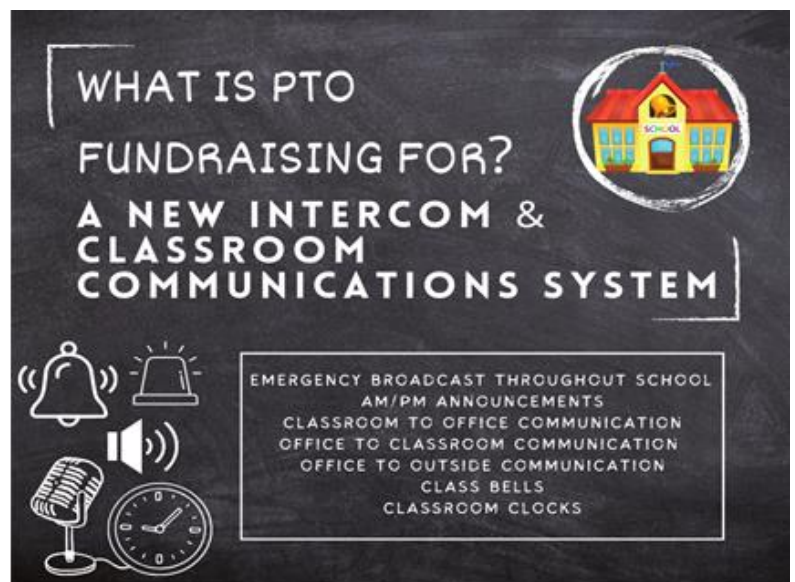
Dear St. Catherine Laboure Families,
